NEWS FROM C.E.R.T.

The seven current members of Laurel Estates C.E.R.T. Team (Community Emergency Response Team) have been busy with on-going training and test taking. There are still three park residents who have to finish some classroom training and testing to be certified team members. They will take care of that in the coming months. There will be a new basic training course given in January (evenings). The dates have not been received yet. You can call Bruce and Jan Zylstra for more information.

During the summer months, we had residents fill out an Emergency Response Form which included information regarding who to call (relative, friend, etc.) in the event a disaster of some type should occur and affect our community. We realize that this is a duplication of information as you may also have this information on file with Flo Cummings. However, we feel it is important for the C.E.R.T. Team to have this on file and readily available in case it is needed. We will work with Flo to make duplications of any updated information you give her.

As we are a new team and a rather small team, in comparison to other parks, there are certain basic items we need to have in the event of a disaster. Flashlights/batteries, work gloves, duct tape, pens/pencils, scissors, wrench sets of different sizes, and first aid kits are just some of the needed items. The fire department of N. Fort Myers has already provided neck braces and will also provide a backboard for our use. If you should wish to donate any of these items or make a monetary donation to the team, please call Bruce or Jan Zylstra.
