'Auld Lang Syne' is the title of a 1788 Scots poem by Robert Burns, typically sung on New Year's Eve around the world. The phrase 'auld lang syne' literally means 'old long since,' and basically means, 'days gone by.' The original, five-verse version of the poem essentially gets people singing, 'let's drink to days gone by'—an appropriate toast for the New Year.

Sometimes deemed the most famous 'song that nobody knows' by music historians, "Auld Lang Syne" is a piece of the long oral tradition of geting drunk and singing. The nostalgic phrase has appeared in Scotish song as early as 1588, but it was poet hero Robert 'Rabbie' Burns who gave us the version we prefer to butcher
