Happy Spring to all of our Laurel Estates residents. Safe Travels to those who will be traveling back to your summer homes, and Easter Blessings to everyone.

Just a brief update of current projects we are working on completing.

- 1) Cameras at the Clubhouse Entrances, estimate has been approved, cameras should be installed no later than 03.31.22.
- 2) Ditch Maintenance Find a Contractor who will clean & Ditch Maintenance Find a Contractor who will be a C
- 3) Ultra 5 has worked with an engineer to get an exact layout of our drainage system. Our first priority is to get the Sink Hole at 2750 Indianawood repaired, we are hoping to have this completed no later than May 15 th 2022.
- 4) Updating Landscaping around clubhouse, this should be completed by end of April 2022.
- 5) New Downspout extensions, have been installed.
- 6) 2 Lights on Boulevard have been reported as not working, they should be working by 04.15.22.
- 7) Paint Pool Fence, should be completed by 03.31.22.
- 8) Review Janitorial Contractors and discuss the lack of cleanliness in bathrooms. I am not happy to hear this is still an issue. We will discuss directly with our contractors, and make any necessary changes.
- 9) HOA Board brought to our attention a few items that need to be addressed at the pool, we are working on those with our pool company.
- 10) Getting estimates to have new tinting installed on windows and doors.
- 11) New Blower Motor and Capacitor installed on one of our AC units.
- 12) Angel's 2 nd Quarter Visit April 11 th 13th 2022

I hope everyone has had a chance to see the newly improved stage. We can accomplish much working together. Thanks to all of those who donated time and talents, it looks amazing.
